## Village Square of Titusville Condo Association Inc.

- Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A: One vote per unit.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my rights to use my unit?
- A: Personal use only; no business use.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium document on the leasing of my unit?
- A: Leasing is restricted to (3) times per year and for not <u>less</u> than (1) month.
- Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?
- A: \$200.00 per month, due the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month. Late fee of \$25.00 is charged if received after tenth day of month.
- Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are my assessments?
- A: No/None
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A: **No.**
- Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so, identify each such case.
- A: No
